- take part in induction training and ongoing development (which will be provided for you)

The enclosed sheet summarises the circumstances under which someone cannot serve as a Governor and parents may not nominate themselves if they are:

- an elected member of the local council
- paid to work in the school for more than 500 hours in any twelve month period
- disqualified from serving as a Governor for any of the reasons listed in the attached disqualification document.

Every Governing Body needs a balance and diversity of knowledge, skills and experience. The Local Governing Body would welcome applications from candidates with a range of experience as we will be reviewing committee appointments for the next academic year and anticipate vacancies on both our Education and Wellbeing Committee and our Finance and Resources Committee.
